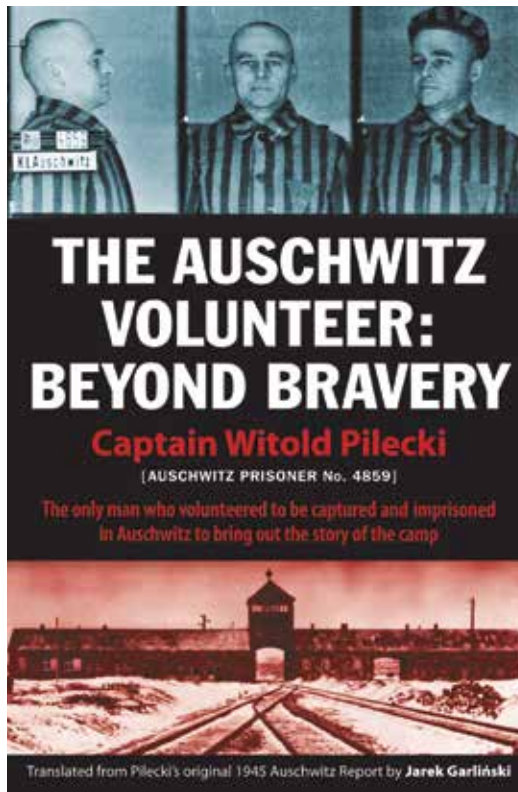

One man volunteered for Auschwitz...and now we have his story. In September 1940, Polish army officer Witold Pilecki volunteered for a secret undercover mission at Auschwitz to smuggle out intelligence and build a resistance organization among the prisoners. He accomplished his mission, surviving starvation, disease and brutality for nearly three years before escaping.

Pilecki's report on his Auschwitz mission, lost for more than fifty years, has recently been published in English for the first time as *The Auschwitz Volunteer: Beyond Bravery*.
